



REI Vendor Inventory Fulfillment (VIF) Label FAQ

REI requires two types of labels for all VIF shipments. This includes the UPS shipping label and the REI GS1-128 (UCC-128) label with the 856 Advanced Shipping Notice.

What is the GS1-128 label?

- The GS1-128 label is a shipping label that is used in conjunction with the EDI 856 Advanced Shipping Notice. Each shipped carton should have a GS1-128 label.

What is the SSCC#?

- This is the serial shipping container code (SSCC) that should be printed alongside the barcode. The SSCC# on the carton should also be the same for the details you send in your 856 Advanced Shipping Notice.

Why does REI require the two different labels?

- REI offers an option for VIF orders to be picked up at a retail location. This requires the GS1-128 label for receiving purposes to notify the customer of their order arriving at the retail location.
