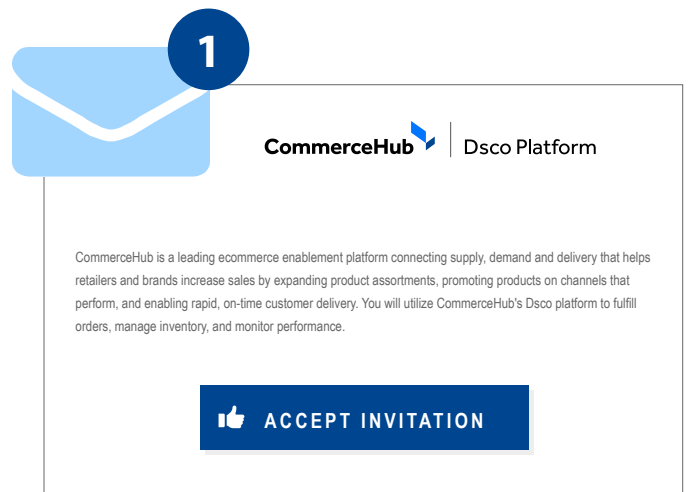
## Here are your next steps!

### 1 Look for the email invitation

Click the button to accept the invitation to CommerceHub's Dsco platform.

### 2 Create your company's account

Create your personal login first. Once you're in, simply provide some basic company details.\*



### 3 Start the Onboarding Wizard

During this step-by-step process, you'll choose your connection method to integrate.

You'll create and run tests against your inventory, order, shipment, and invoice data as needed.

Your progress is saved along the way

We've seen some suppliers complete onboarding in as little as one day, but you can invite your colleagues to work with you and complete the process in multiple sessions if needed.

#### Data Flexibility!

The Dsco platform can send and receive data in almost any combination of file format (CSV, Excel, EDI, JSON) and transport protocol (SFTP, AS2, API).

You'll want to have your company's preferred file and connection type in mind before you begin the wizard.

### 4 Go Live!

Neiman Marcus will receive a notification once you complete the wizard. They can then begin receiving your inventory data and sending you orders, so reach out to Neiman Marcus for the exact date you'll be going live!

\* The Dsco platform requires a separate account for each retailer connection, so you'll need to complete step 2 even if you're already connected to a retailer on the Dsco platform.
